- Read the first page, see if it gets your attention!




Read Your Book

- You should try and read a bit every day!
- If you're keeping a reading log, make sure to update it regularly
- When reading longer books try to make some brief notes after reading so you can remember key ideas and parts of the text
- You're ready to take the quiz when you've finished reading the book!



Taking an Accelerated Reader Quiz











- Quizzes can have anywhere from 3 questions, up to 20 depending on the length of the book.




